The Longines League of Nations™ Standings is the ranking established by adding the points earned at each of the League of Nations™ Qualifying Competitions.

After the last Longines League of Nations™ Qualifying Competition of the Season the Final Standings are established to determine the teams qualified for the Longines League of Nations™ Final. The team's results in all Longines League of Nations™ Qualifying Competitions count towards the Final Standings.

At every Longines League of Nations™ Competition at Longines League of Nations™ Qualifiers the following points are allocated to the placed teams:

If the Home Nation is not automatically qualified for the Longines League of Nations™ Event via the Qualification Ranking and finishes in the top 10 of the Classification at a Longines League of Nations™ Qualifying Competition, the Home Nation's result shall be disregarded for the purpose of allocating Longines League of Nations™ points. For example if that Home Nation finishes in first place in the LLN Competition, the NF that finished in second place will receive 100 points, the NF that finished in third place will receive 90 points and so on.

The eight best teams of the Final Standings are qualified for the Longines League of Nations™ Final, Barcelona (ESP), 1-4 October 2026.

In case of a tie for the eighth place the NF that has won the most Longines League of Nations™ Competitions during that Longines League of Nations™ Season, will qualify for the Longines League of Nations™ Final. In case after applying this mechanism the tie continues, the NF with the most second places will be qualified and so on until the tie is decided. In case the tie cannot be broken, the team with the higher ranking in the Longines League of Nations™ Ranking preceding the last Longines League of Nations™ Qualifier will qualify for the Final. If there is still a tie after applying the foregoing tiebreakers, the FEI will hold a draw.
